

Arise! Women's Conference

Passionate worship. Exalted presence. Hundreds and hundreds of hungry women soaking up truth like parched ground receiving rain. Standing on the platform teaching, I swear I could hear the sounds of a desert coming alive.

In arid places where the land is cracked and dry there is a certain sound that the earth makes when the rain falls. It is an intense sound. Like a sharp involuntary intake of breath combined with a sob of delight, and an ecstatic smile.

I know the needs and the dilemmas of this body of people...thanks to the intel. It was important, vital even, not to preach into the problem, but to speak to a place above it. To talk to the Christ-life within each person. In order to raise up the New Man of the Spirit we must speak to that identity. Whatever we speak to, rises up in people.

I spoke on "Building a New Mindset", using the "Power of Instead to Turn Problems into Possibilities", "Taking Thoughts Captive Using Joy" and "Inheritance Words". Along the way the Holy Spirit destroyed negative speculation, enhanced the place of the Beloved, made people laugh and feel good about themselves, and pulled down some religious strongholds.

We wanted people to understand the sheer astonishing quality of their salvation in Jesus. We wanted people to know that the only way to live this life is to be astonished. We wanted people to know that they are truly dead in Christ and to enjoy walking in newness of life.

We watched people coming alive in the Lord. In Africa I have prayed for the land around rural villages. Scripture says that "the creation longs for the appearance of the Sons of God." (Romans 8:22) That is, the earth longs to be rescued and released from being unproductive. I have prayed for rain to fall and have seen the heavens open. I have gone back later and seen crops growing strong and tall where once there was an arid wasteland.

I wonder what will grow out of this event. If I was a gambling man I would push all my chips to the center of the table and bet it all on Jesus and Arise! women coming alive into full fruition and focus. I totally love this event! It was a distinct joy and pleasure to be "one of the girls" for a weekend!

Frontline – The Portland Sessions

I have many snapshots in my heart from the Portland Sessions:

- Laughter at Mama Mia's restaurant on Monday night
- The buzz of animated conversation as members shared their insights on "Expanding our Capacity"
- Bright eyes as you prophesied to each other in the picture activation
- The quiet Presence that you moved in while praying over the room before the sessions... and the tangible one that remained throughout.
- The transformational power of revelation, as Graham masterfully unfolded each stage of maturity and the great conversations amongst us that followed.

But most of all, I found it once again, to be a time of crossing thresholds. In our gathering day, it felt as if we were crossing into a new level of community. A feeling of being established as a group that naturally gets together, even when there were many new faces in the room for most of us. The sense of connection based on our common ground of TWC was stronger than I've ever experienced it. It had a sense of being settled: this is who we are and what we do - we're warriors and friends in a fight we love, praying, sharing our stories and learning together.

For the event itself, it had a sense for me of Graham crossing over into a bigger landscape than ever before. Which is funny, because the room was rather small. But it won't be for long. I know Graham has done his own conferences before, but this is a new season with amazing new possibilities... limitless ones for him and for us.

I loved that we were there in a company of friends, with BBH having provided an excellent set up; Bob Book, creating highways from heaven to earth in worship and TWCers on site welcoming delegates at the registration table and quietly praying in the room each morning.

We've already gotten numerous reports of people walking in and tangibly feeling God's presence, of fragrances in the room and face to face experiences with Him. Together, we created an atmosphere for encounter.

And then there was the teaching. It was the most massive threshold, that opened up a new level of revelation. Each session took a stage of our maturity and powerfully opened up the mindsets, encounters and aspects of God's nature we experience in each. I felt like a million dots were being connected in how many of Graham's classic teachings related to each level. It was practical, powerful and wonderfully challenging. It loosed a tsunami of questions to ponder and possibilities to pursue.

Graham suggested that it would take about 2 years to process those four teachings... and that doesn't really seem long enough. But I'm already diving in!

Thanks to all of you who prayed into the Portland Sessions and to those who spent time and resources to be present, to volunteer and to intercede on site. We're looking forward to more days and times like these as Graham's Kingdom territory for these events expands. There are religious dragons and sleeping giants just waiting for us to arrive!

Graham says "Thanks" to TWC members in Portland



Here is an excerpt from the transcript of Graham's comments to The Warrior Class during our gathering in Portland:

Thanks for getting me and AI into trouble! The Warrior Class has been such a great ride. It is a little like a roller coaster: you have those slow moments when you are climbing to get to a scary point and then it is "wheeee!" as you go down. It is definitely not for the faint of heart! I appreciate you guys sticking with me - sticking with us.

We love the Warrior Class, not just for what it can do but because we are finally getting a group of people who really want to go on a journey and change their story. It means a lot to be able to mentor the number of people that we are, and we plan to mentor a lot more...just to have several hundred people who are learning how to be game-changers, warriors and champions.

We are not ordinary people because there is nothing ordinary about us. That is what I like about The Warrior Class. We are not doing ordinary. We want extraordinary people who are traveling with us, who want to go the extra mile and become amazing.

Honestly, I think that this is the only way to represent Jesus. **YOU** have to be amazing. It is not enough for Him that you think He is amazing. He is in the business of making you like Him, which means you have to own up to the fact that, "*Hey, I have to be amazing. That is my journey. That is my outcome!*" Because we get to be like Him. At some point, people are supposed to be astonished by **you** - and that is going to be so cool, since I was never astonishing as a kid!

I love what we are doing, the fact that we are learning how to encounter and experience the Lord. We get to think like Him, talk like Him, do the stuff that He does. We get to change people's situations and circumstances!

We are going to get to the point in The Warrior Class where we can't be challenged by our circumstances. Our circumstances are going to be challenged by **us**. When we get to that place, everything turns on its head. We get to move in ways of thinking and seeing that are brilliant and amazing; a point where we look and say, "This set of circumstances is not here to challenge me. It is here so that I can learn to challenge it." We challenge those things through the language of our promises, our prophecies and our inheritance words, because they are more real than our circumstances.

The thing that made Caleb a man of a different spirit was that he got it. He really got it! He understood that the giants were there to show him the majesty of God. So he was super-excited about giants! He understood majesty and sovereignty; it became a major part of his story, his journey. And that was in an Old Testament culture of visitation! The New Testament reveals a habitational culture, so it means we get to "get it" in a completely different way.

When Allison and I butt heads together and chat, that is what we talk about all the time: **the fact that people are getting it**. We want to be that message. I want to be that extraordinary and I want to represent Jesus in the fullest. That means that we have to be amazing together. I want us to be a world-class, supernatural, intercessory company of people who are happy and not stressed. I want us to have solid encounters with God that make us a remarkable company of people.

So we love days like this. We love times like this. We love events like this. We appreciate you guys being part of our story and journey and we are glad to get to play a small part in yours.



TWC Training Day

Questions regarding the TWC Training Day



Ellen Scharffenberg - Lionheart Team Leader

What relational connections did you make or increase? And how do these impact your TWC journey?

The TWC training day was such a great venue for developing relationship. As the "band of brothers" share their learning, the Holy Spirit braids a connection that lasts, especially with email.

What "light bulbs" went on in a new way?

I love how joy expands our capacity to take altitude. Another "light bulb" was realizing that opposition is resistance training.

What part of the "capacity" teaching or activations did you connect with?

I am learning, like a winning race horse, or a Top Gun fighter pilot to step up boldly and embrace a need, "A need for speed!" As the daughter of a Top Gun pilot, I know first-hand the training it takes and also the benefit of "taking it out for a spin." I am now stepping more boldly into the altitude in my ever-upgrading identity with the Holy Spirit, and it is amazing!

What did Graham & Theresa's visit mean to you?

What a great thing, for warriors to be connected to their leaders! By opening up to the gathering of warriors in the training, it helped to set the stage for more precise intercession for the event. We could visually (and prophetically) see some of the unspoken needs they had. And it is a humbling delight and honor to be privileged to pray for this amazing couple who devote themselves to the kingdom.

What was a key point of Graham's teaching that you want to explore more?

"I am so part of the creative side of nature."

In level 4, I want to explore and soak in more of full maturity. I loved Graham's statements, "Don't ever underestimate the anointing you have. 93-95% is going to be weird; God loves weird!"

What did you experience in the pre-service intercession or interacting with others attending?

Tuesday evening, every chair and wall in the room was covered with purity and clarity so that the attendees were able to absorb what Graham was going to say. Wednesday morning we cleared out negativity and brought blessing and joy into the room - especially the corners and doorways. Wednesday afternoon we prayed for Bob (Book) and spread joy in the room. Wednesday night we declared upgrades and breakthroughs for attendees and stamina for Graham.

What upgrades did you experience?

I experienced strength in leadership abilities and insights. The Holy Spirit had some divine appointments with new Warriors who were struggling with the amount of information they thought they needed to know and/or complete. As a prior performance addict, I was able to give grace and focus about how to progress in TWC.

I also received an upgrade in delivering prophecy to specific individuals during the private times (amazingly!) that God set up. Each person was touched by the Holy Spirit uniquely and it was so fun being the conduit of blessing!

Jonathan Gilbert – Lionheart Team

What relational connections did you make or increase? How do these impact your TWC journey?

This was my first conference as a TWC member so it was great to meet some of the warriors and build those connections. I enjoyed meeting Allison and hearing her heart and vision. It really opened the window on The Warrior Class and its mission.

What "light bulbs" went on in a new way?

It takes a large capacity to lead an intentional life. Since intentionality is one of my goals, I will have to work on my capacity in order for it to grow.

What part of the "capacity" teaching or activations did you connect with?

Capacity implies responsibility. Utilizing it requires understanding, focus, desire and ability. You don't really know your capacity until you take it out for a spin. Fine tuning can increase it.

What was a key point of Graham's teaching that you want to explore more?

I really liked what Graham had to say about the 4 stages of Christian growth exemplified by the 4 Greek words used in the NT to describe babies, young children, teens and fully mature adults. In each stage, he talked about the characteristics, limitations and permissions that the person enjoys. I want to put it into a table that will enable us to compare the stages and see the transitions in our lives from one stage to another.

What did you experience in the pre-service intercession or interacting with others attending?

I particularly enjoyed being the weatherman, bringing the atmosphere of heaven to the room before the crowd arrived.

What upgrades did you experience?

I am re-committed to participating in my own growth and development with God.

Kristy Lindvall - Northern Lights Team

The relationships during our team conference call the week after the Portland Session went to another level. We are more tightly knit for the things we experienced. We are truly a team in the sense that those who were unable to go covered those who did, and those who went brought back every ounce they could to share with the team. We understand more clearly the importance of what we do as a prayer team, and as members of TWC.

I am excited about expanding my prophetic capacity through writing "practice words" for pictures, as we did during one training session. Allison suggested cutting out all sorts of pictures from magazines, and interpreting the story behind the picture. She then shared how the Holy Spirit had used some of the practice pictures that she had done to speak to an individual later on. In practicing this, I hope to be better prepared to partner with the Holy Spirit in bringing words to people.

One of the biggest chains that fell off of me was the need to know if I was hearing the same thing as others regarding intel for assignments. We were encouraged to embrace our uniqueness, work off of what the Holy Spirit highlighted to us as individuals, and kill that sucker of "right or wrong" flat out dead!

From Kathy Brown – Gold Team Leader

What was a key point of Graham's teaching that you want to explore more?

Graham talked to us about truth taught in 3 levels. The first level teaches on the surface. The 2nd level changes who you are. On the 3rd level you encounter God.

Teachers who teach from the 3rd level bring a greater dimension into their teaching that gives new and fresh revelation every time you hear it. This is exactly how Graham teaches. I am continually given deeper revelation every time I dig in the wells of Graham's teaching! How wonderful it is to be a part of this team in TWC to support what Graham gives to the Kingdom of God!

Janis Morgan – Northern Lights Team

What relational connections did you make or increase? And how do these impact your TWC journey?

I received words from strangers, who quickly became friends, concerning things I am currently facing that they would have no idea about. It built trust among us and revealed the faithfulness of God.

What part of the "capacity" teaching or activations did you connect with?

Capacity is the ability to receive and contain impressions and knowledge. We have the ability in Christ to receive immeasurable amounts of everything He has, without restriction. Our capacity is limitless, but must be developed. When revelation comes, it fills those places within us that yearn for more of Him. We become satisfied and our walk with God is greatly enhanced. Since there is no limit to our capacity, it expands to make room for more. We are capable of encounter with Him, He grants us encounter, and then HE makes room for more. Through this process our capacity is expanded.

What did Graham & Theresa's visit mean to you?

Allison made the statement that TWC is not a fan club. Even though I didn't speak with Graham and Theresa other than saying hello, there was a connection made with them, and praying for them immediately felt different; more personal, more like a partnership. Graham dedicates time to know the secrets of God, and then takes Him to the places he goes. Because of the life-changing messages God allows him to carry, he is seen by many as a celebrity of sorts. In Portland he became more personal to me. I saw him as Graham, a man who spends himself on God to bring His message to many. It felt like friendship. Covering he and Theresa in that endeavor is an important and intimate process. I am called to intercede, and I now feel it in a more personal way.

What was a key point of Graham's teaching that you want to explore more?

Graham spoke about our limitless supply of love, faith, joy, peace, and patience. Why we would EVER choose anything less? If we get bruised in any of these areas, just go to God to be replenished and then get on with what we are being asked to do. This is the answer to so much! Go to the Father to get refilled of whatever the world has stolen and get on with life, get on with HIS purposes, get on with LOVE. I want to live like that – COMPLETELY!

What did you experience in the pre-service intercession or interacting with others attending?

At the pre-service intercession we welcomed the Holy Spirit to take His place, for those who were attending, but also for US as well. I was interceding for Graham as he was speaking AND for those around me who were listening for the first time. The presence of the Holy Spirit intensified as I watched and heard him "land" on those around me. I too was taken deeper into what the Holy Spirit had to say to me personally. IT WAS A BLAST!

What upgrades did you experience?

Graham said that there is no place for powerless Christians in this world. "What is the point of being in a Kingdom that is not of this world if we don't carry a power that is not of this world?" He said that nothing should rob us of the power of Heaven and that no one but Satan benefits from powerless Christians. I was given the upgraded desire and power to fight the devil who has come to steal everything!

Kathy Huff - Warrior Eagles Team

Before the crowd arrived, I had the opportunity to contribute positively to the atmosphere, and actually had a vision of the Holy Spirit brooding over the chairs asking "Who is going to receive? Who is going to be transformed?" As the attendees began entering, I was able to interact with them, either with a smile or a greeting. My "light bulb" experience was when Graham said that if we are not able to receive, we do not represent Jesus correctly. I want to chew on that and find out what it takes for me to be able to receive completely and joyfully.

My upgrade was being able to be comfortable in a room full of strangers, to the extent I started a conversation with them and thoroughly enjoyed it!

Jimetta Mayne – Diamond Team Leader

What relational connections did you make or increase? And how do these impact your TWC journey?

Every relational connection at the Training Day was fabulous. The caliber of people who were there was awe inspiring. The training that TWC offers has produced a high level of people you rarely find in the Kingdom. I heard from almost everyone that when they found Graham's teaching, and then discovered TWC, they "found others with their DNA" and "I found my tribe". TWC has created a beautiful prophetic culture that I haven't seen before.

What part of the "capacity" teaching or activations did you connect with?

The capacity teaching was very stretching, but extremely encouraging. Allison nailed every point with beautiful illustrations and testimonies. I was challenged with each piece, but the picture activation messed me up in a spectacular way. We had just received the word on capacity. When we did the picture activation, I had a plan. I had done this activation before, so I picked a picture that I thought no one would want, and then determined in my heart to prophecy to this person an amazing word that would ROCK their world as they know it, calling them up higher. Well, Holy Spirit had Allison change the activation, and in the end my AMAZING word was for me! I was shocked, for I realized I would not have prophesied that over myself. Holy Spirit and I had a bit of a dialogue about why I would not have called myself up that high. False humility raised its ugly head along with a new perspective of a Religious Spirit. Well, I won't partner with any of that, so I repented and had another thought, received that word, and am choosing to go there. Game on! It is a bit daunting, don't know what that looks like, I know it will have to be supernatural... but who wants to live a "normal life"?

What did Graham & Theresa's visit mean to you?

I was very surprised to see them; it meant so much. We got to see Graham and Theresa's heart toward TWC and what it means to them. We got a piece of the strategy for the sessions so we could support and partner with Graham and Holy Spirit at a greater level.

What was a key point of Graham's teaching that you want to explore more?

The 4 levels of relationship. As I looked at the timeline of my Christian walk I could see where I needed to shore up some of those things that needed to be learned in each season to have a better foundation to go on to a new, more intimate relationship at the next place of maturity. It inspired me to explore!

What did you experience in the pre-service intercession or interacting with others attending?

I loved saturating the room with an atmosphere of expectation of having an intimate heavenly encounter during worship. Bob ROCKED it; heaven always invades when he sets the tone! The interacting with others was so special, to hear their stories and to have God encounters at every turn was mind blowing. This could totally become my new "normal"!

What upgrades did you experience?

Expanded capacity. God got bigger and more majestic - How Great is Our God?

Permission for Childlike Creativity.

Starting to see how far my umbrella of favor will stretch, and how many I can put under it?

Permission to redefine myself and my relationships.
